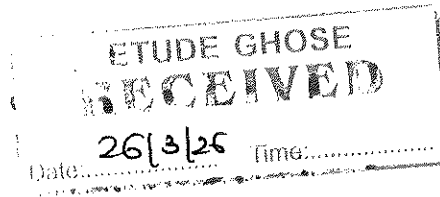

**Re: Hammerhead International Ltd v/s The Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security
& Anor (SCR No. 125458 (1/27/24))**

I appear instructing Ms N. Parsuramen, of Counsel for Defendants in the above matter which is coming on 28 May 2026 before the Supreme Court.

I refer to your letter dated 20 January 2026.

The Division of Veterinary Services carried out a site visit on 26 January 2026 at the premises where the long-tailed macaques seized from Jin Fei on March 2023 are being kept and has reported the following status:

- (i) Number of live Non- Human Primates (NHPs): 192;
- (ii) Number of dead NHPs: 73;
- (iii) Number of NHPs tested positive for Tuberculosis (TVB) and euthanised: 178;
- (iv) The cause of death of the NHPs varies among trauma, injuries and diarrhea; and
- (v) From 14th to 21st round of TB testing all remaining live NHPs were tested negative.
